Welcome Rev. Edward Jenkins

Rev. Edward Jenkins was born in Jamaica, West Indies. He accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his personal Savior in November 1995, but received his formative teaching in God's Word way before then from his grandmother, Elizabeth. In August 1978, he felt a call to the Christian ministry and subsequently applied to the United Theological College of the West Indies to be trained as a minister of the Jamaica Baptist Union.

Upon graduation, he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Theology and was commissioned as a pastor in the Bethany Circuit of Baptist Churches in 1985. He was ordained to the Christian ministry in 1987 and served for four years before immigrating to the United States in 1998. Eventually, he joined the Presbyterian Church of St Albans, in Queens, New York, pastored by Rev. Dr. Edward Davis, and became Youth Coordinator for that church. He worked there for four years focusing on the community through the C.A.R.R.Y Ministry (Concerned Adults Reaching At-Risk Youth), run by the church. His worked included arranging trips for the youth to weekend retreats, basketball programs to keep them off the streets and yearly "Increase the Peace" youth symposiums to address the issue of gun violence and conflict resolution.


While serving at St. Albans, Rev. Jenkins accepted a call to Ebenezer Wesleyan Methodist Church in Brooklyn and was installed as its 11th pastor in March 1995. He has served there now for 21 years. He loves the Lord and loves people and is passionate about ministry and about the power of the Word of God to change lives.

In 2009, Rev. Jenkins was accepted as a graduate student at Northeastern Seminary in Rochester. He reconnected with his good friend, Rev. Dr. Peter Grinion, with whom he often stayed while studying. In May 2013, Edward graduated from Northeastern Seminary with a Master of Divinity in Theology.

On Nov. 4, 2014, working with Rev. Kevin Jones, Rev. Jenkins founded Brooklyn Clergy Action Network To Save Our Communities, a not-for profit 501c3 Organization geared specifically to address the problem of gun violence in Brooklyn communities. Rev. Jenkins and his wife, Angella, live in East Flatbush Brooklyn. They have three children, Renee, Rochelle, and Edward L Jenkins Jr.
