That's when the culminating celebration of West Henrietta Baptist Church's bicentennial will be held. The day will begin with a special worship service followed by an open house and hors d'oeuvres at the church. At 1 pm, a banquet will be held at the RIT Inn and Conference Center on Wet Henrietta Road. Roy Medley, general secretary of the American Baptist Churches USA, has agreed to speak. Tickets will be \$25. The bicentennial committee is still brainstorming a guest list, and your suggestions on whom should be invited are welcome.

OTHER DATES TO SAVE:

Our yearlong celebration will launch officially at the Deacons' Retreat on Saturday, October 11, 2014 with "Mystic Sweet Communion." The identities of our fellow church members in the stained glass windows and the 1911 McFarlane Class hanging in the Fellowship Hall will be revealed. Be sure to come learn their stories and who in today's congregation claims ancestors among them.

Observing the bicentennial across calendar years makes sense because our church actually began worshipping in 1813 in homes along the Genesee River. They formalized their organization 1815 with the adoption of a covenant. Starting our celebrations in 2014 recognizes that pre-1815 history. Events are being planned for each month from October 2014 through September 2015. Other 2014 events include:

*On Tuesday, November 25, with our Christmas greens beautifully laid, we plan to

host the annual interfaith Thanksgiving service and highlight our historic connections with other churches.

* On Saturday, December 13, we will host an old-fashioned caroling party for our neighbor churches. After singing, cookies and hot chocolate will be served at our church.

From the Board of Trustees West Henrietta Baptist Church To all of our congregants, You may have heard talk around church about buying the vacant lot on the corner of Erie Station and West Henrietta Roads. The purpose of this letter is to inform the congregation and present the rationale for the proposal. At the January, 2014 congregational meeting, the trustees were tasked with coming up with a plan to address our future parking needs, namely, by proposing a plan for purchasing the lot across Erie Station Road. West Henrietta is growing, and it's reasonable to expect that some day the fire dept. may outgrow the existing firehouse and relocate to a new, larger facility, which is what happened in Scottsville about 15 years ago. Or it may close due to consolidation, as in West Brighton a couple of years ago. If that happens, we'll probably lose the parking privileges that we've come to take for granted for all these years. If that happens, what can we do? We could build a remote lot somewhere and shuttle people here, or beg parking privileges from Cartwright's new owner, whoever that will be. We could abandon our building and build a new one somewhere else, with its own parking. Or we could provide our own parking here by purchasing the vacant lot. As Christians, we believe that God will take care of our needs, but maybe He is taking care of this by presenting us this opportunity. We are initiating a pledge drive for purchasing the lot, with the pledges contingent on a congregational vote to proceed with the purchase. If we raise \$50,000-\$60,000, added to the money already available in our treasury, the situation may be attractive enough for the congregation to approve. If not, the effort hasn't cost us anything. Also, the pledges may be paid over a few years' time. The pledge cards may be dropped in the weekly collection basket, or mailed to the church at 5660 West Henrietta Road., West Henrietta, NY 14586. When the pledges are all in, the congregation will meet to discuss the proposal and vote on whether to proceed. Thank you, The Board of Trustees.
