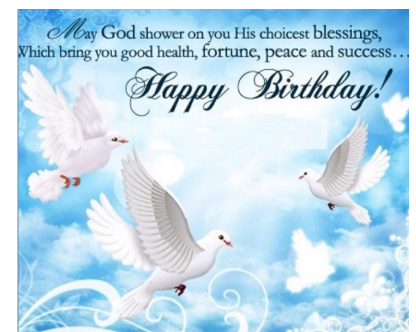

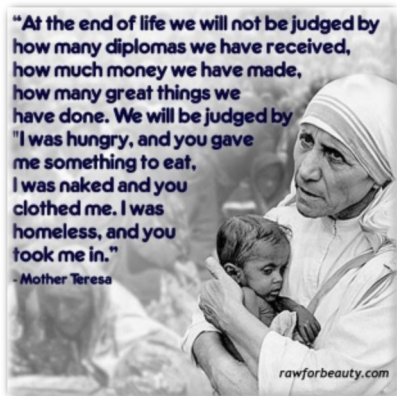

Remember to sign up to host Fellowship Hour.



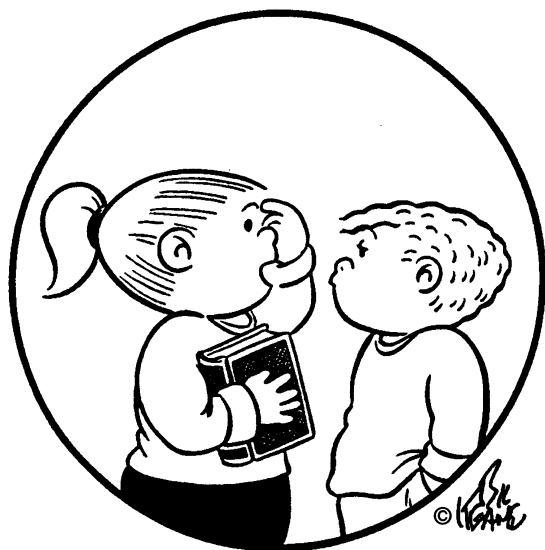
