Here are my five requests of you: 1) avail yourself to be the "core" of the church and can be counted on for your regular attendance; 2) assume a leadership role among your friends and colleagues and allow God to

use you to encourage, nurture them, or lead them to a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ 3) Call a neighbor every week, a few days before Sunday, and invite them to accompany you to church. Follow up with them throughout the week; 4) Call fellow church members who are weak in attendance and remind them about church worship service. The truth is that fellow church members are less likely to be absent if they know somebody misses them; and 5) Pray daily for your church. Make intercessions daily for your pastor, moderator, deacons, choristers, and the various committees/boards.

Let's experience what God has in store for us at West Henrietta Baptist Church! Let our song be: Take my life and let it be, consecrated Lord to Thee!


