Moment for History

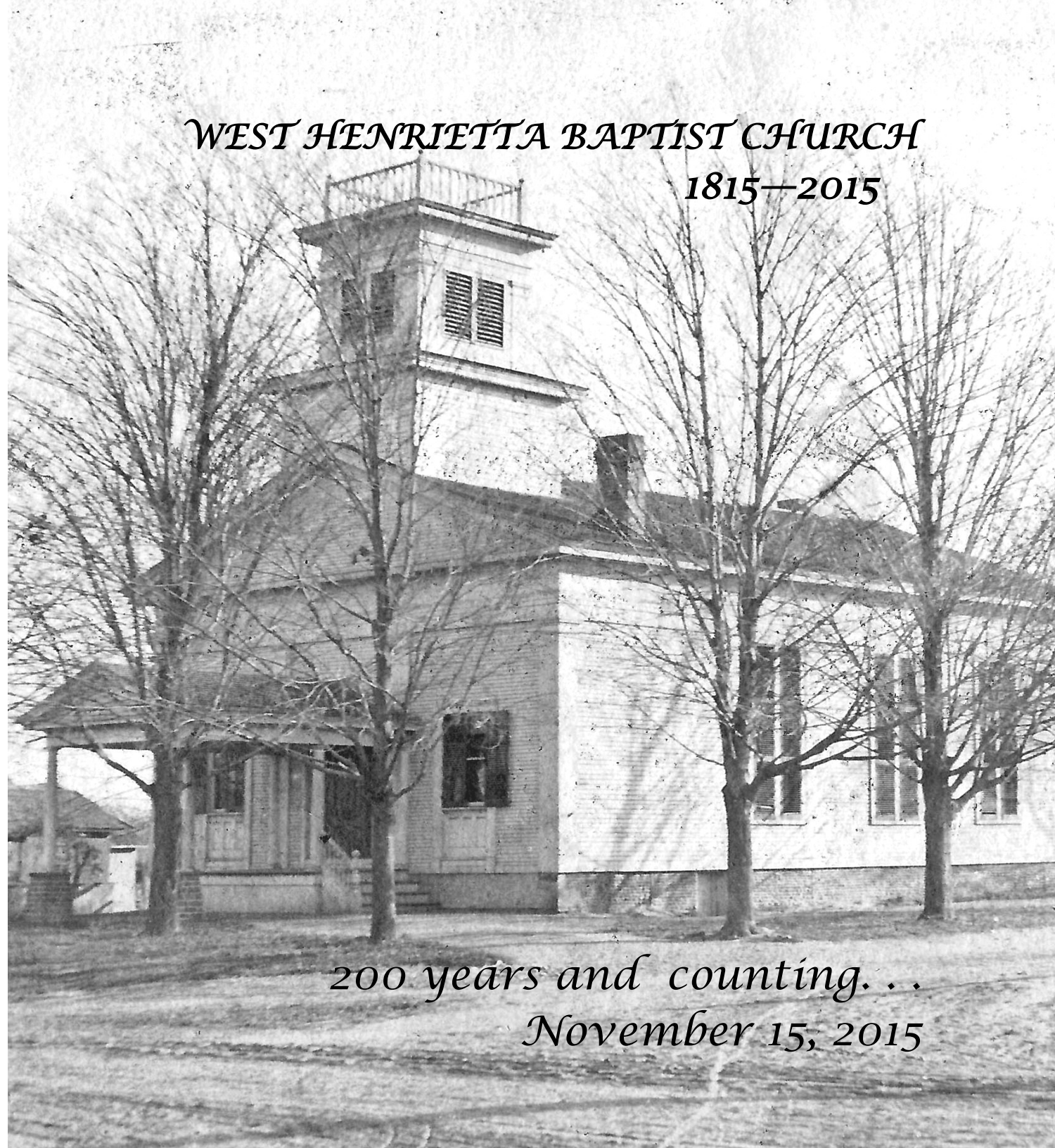
During World War II, gasoline shortages made it difficult for members to get to some functions. Food rations were received by various groups of the church, so they could continue dinners.
