### **Pot Luck Dinner Next Sunday**

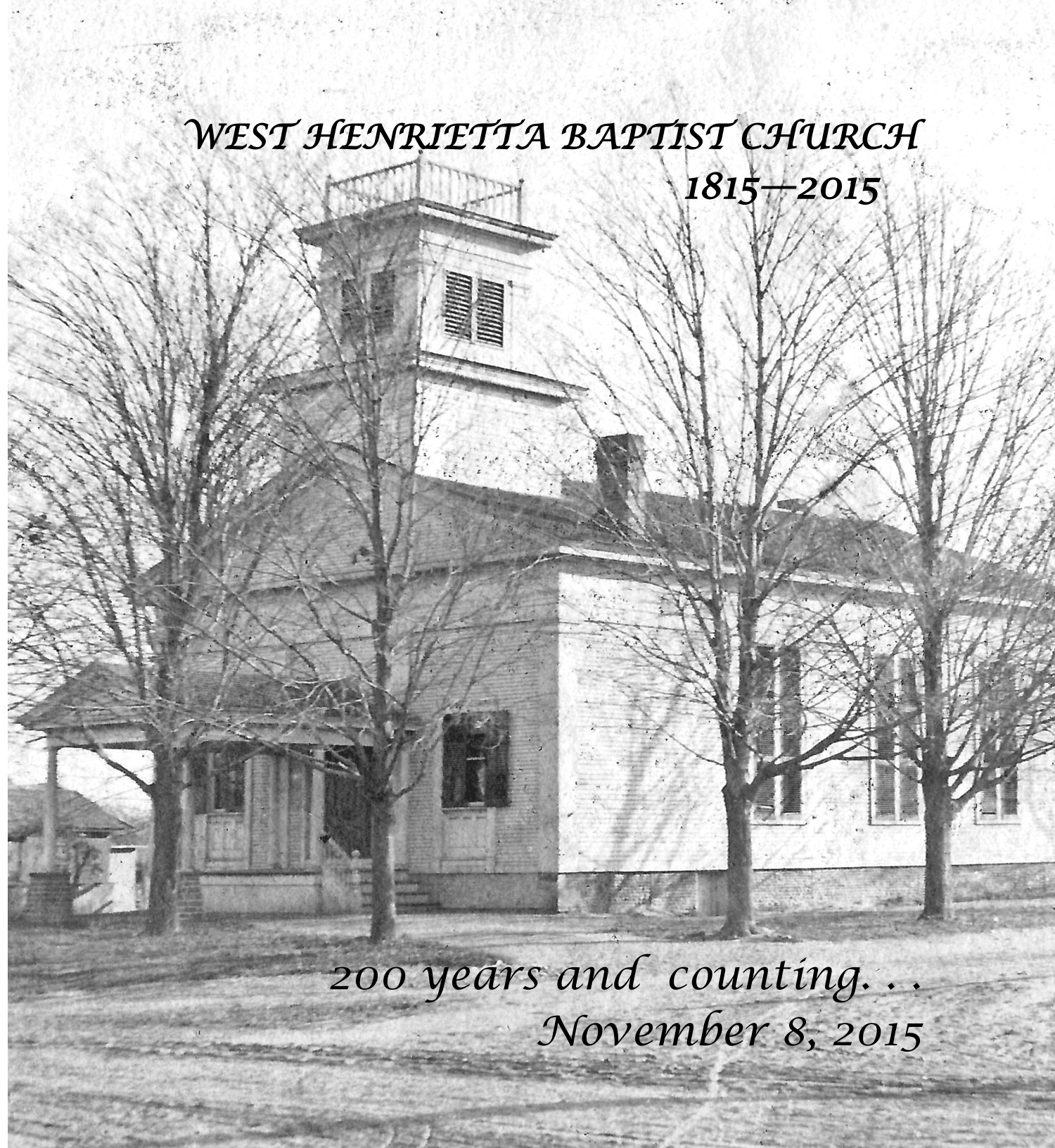
